Good Shepherd Overview

The Good Shepherd represents Jesus, as Jesus was and is the Good Shepherd. He/she encourages the members to grow in their faith by attending a Share Group and the monthly Gatherings. The Good Shepherd is a member of the Emmaus Board of Directors and can serve up to three years.

Staffing and Tasks:

- 3. Encourage all members to attend the Gatherings.
- 4. Provides information and materials for Pilgrim and team information packets on walk weekends.
- 5. Care and feeding of the Heart of Emmaus flock
- 6. Shepherding the Heart of Ohio Emmaus Community

Additional Tasks could include:

- 1. The Good Shepherd is responsible for weekend non-food agape (letters, general, table and personal) (Agape currently does this.)
- 2. Sends and receives general agape of other communities (Agape is currently doing this.)
- 3. Provides information and materials for Pilgrim and team information packets on walk weekends. (See attached letter.)
