

Outreach Duties and Tasks

Outreach Overview

The Outreach Chairman coordinates and facilitates publicity about Emmaus movement and specifically the Heart of Ohio Emmaus community's activities to other communities and non-Emmaus persons or groups and churches.

Outreach Staffing

Outreach chairman is a member of the Emmaus Community Board of Directors and responsible for overall leadership and direction of the Outreach Team.

It is suggested that team also include 2-3 community members, and 1-2 clergy persons that is led by the chairperson.

General Event Tasks

- Be very passionate.
- Relating very well to church leadership.
- Is experienced and very knowledgeable.
- Able to answer all questions.
- Ecumenical.
- Remind all that we are partners with our churches.
- Coordinate 2 family community activities each year, such as a picnic and holiday gathering.
- Begin announcing the performance requests in July by announcing them in the Newsletter and at gatherings.
- Recruit 10 performers.
- Organize an order of performance program ahead of time and hand out to those who are in the program.
- Outreach oversees announcing each performance at Gathering.
- Promote and motivate the HOO community members to participate in community Gatherings, as well as the national Emmaus Conference.
- Maintain contacts with other Emmaus Communities.
- Promote the Emmaus movement to other non-Emmaus persons or groups.
- Coordinate all publicity: brochure and poster distribution, articles to the District and Conference Newsletters.
